- 5. Junior, Open Barrows and Commercial Gilts will be weighed at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, August 3. Logan County 4-H Barrows and Commercial Gilts will not be re-weighed. Barrows and Commercial Gilts will be divided into classes after weigh-in at the Superintendents discretion. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their Barrows and Commercial Gilts to the scales at weigh-in. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 6. All ear notches must be checked by the superintendent or designated show official. Any notches not matching the show paperwork will be disqualified at superintendent's discretion.
- 7. Satisfactory proof of the breeding of each animal must be furnished to the Superintendent on or before Thursday, August 3 at 8:30 a.m.
- 8. Check entry receipt for accuracy when making entries. No entry changes or corrections will be made at the scale or in show ring. Have back tags available at scale and show ring.
- 9. Registration and health papers will be checked at 8:30 a.m. Thursday, August 3.
- 10. No swine will be unloaded without health papers.
- 11. All entries in this department are subject to the General Rules.
- 12. Definitions: Gilts, January 1, 2023 to January 20, 2023; Gilts, January 21, 2023 to February 10, 2023; Gilts, February 11, 2023 to February 28, 2023; March 1, 2023 and after.
- 13. All swine must be owned by June 1, 2023 by exhibitor.
